The Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons of Alabama Home Safety plan is to enable Master Masons to stay in their own homes for a longer period of time rather than having to move into an assisted living facility. This program will pay for materials to enable lodges to install ramps, railing and other safety devices in a home owned by the member. All construction projects must meet all local building codes and must be permitted if local regulations require a building permit.

All financial grants are at the sole discretion of the Charitable Outreach Committee. It is imperative that you review the program guidelines prior to completing the application form and have the intended recipient sign the hold harmless waiver and a statement that he understand that no future assistance is promised prior to mailing this application. Applications must be mailed to Grand Lodge of Alabama F&AM, P O Box 1070, Millbrook, Alabama 36054.
