**(Instructions to applicant - This page is to be submitted with your package)**

The purpose for the Alabama Masonic Scholarship Program is to provide financial assistance to university, college, or technical school students. Preference will be given, but not limited, to applicants who have a father, stepfather, brother, uncle, grandfather, or step-grandfather who is, or was at the time of his death, a Master Mason in good standing in an Alabama Masonic Lodge.

The applicant must be domiciled in the state of Alabama except for the purpose of attending school, provide proof of acceptance or attendance in an accredited post graduate or technical school and demonstrate and maintain an acceptable level of academic achievement.

Recipients of aid under this program must agree to the requirements of Alabama Masonic Code Edict 20.5, which states that no future act of assistance can be promised by anyone.

Recipients of aid in one year may reapply for assistance in future years.

Evaluation of applications and final selection of scholarship recipients are considered final. All information submitted and discussed by the committee shall remain confidential.

Scholarship application forms are available from local Masonic Lodges or by downloading from the Grand Lodge web site ([www.alafreemasonry.org](http://www.alafreemasonry.org)).

The applicant is responsible to ensure that the submission package is complete and submitted in time to arrive at the Grand Lodge by the close of business February 29, 2012. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Faxed copies and packages left outside the Grand Lodge door will not be accepted.

Selections will normally be made during the first week of May or as soon as practical thereafter.

To the extent possible, a representative of the Masonic fraternity will present scholarship awards to recipients in an appropriate ceremony at the recipient's school or local Masonic Lodge.

- I have identified my kinship to a current or deceased Alabama Mason. (If applicable)
- I understand that no further financial assistance is implied (Edict 20.5)
- I agree to participate in a presentation ceremony

- I have submitted high school or college transcripts.
- I have the proper signature(s) on the application form.
